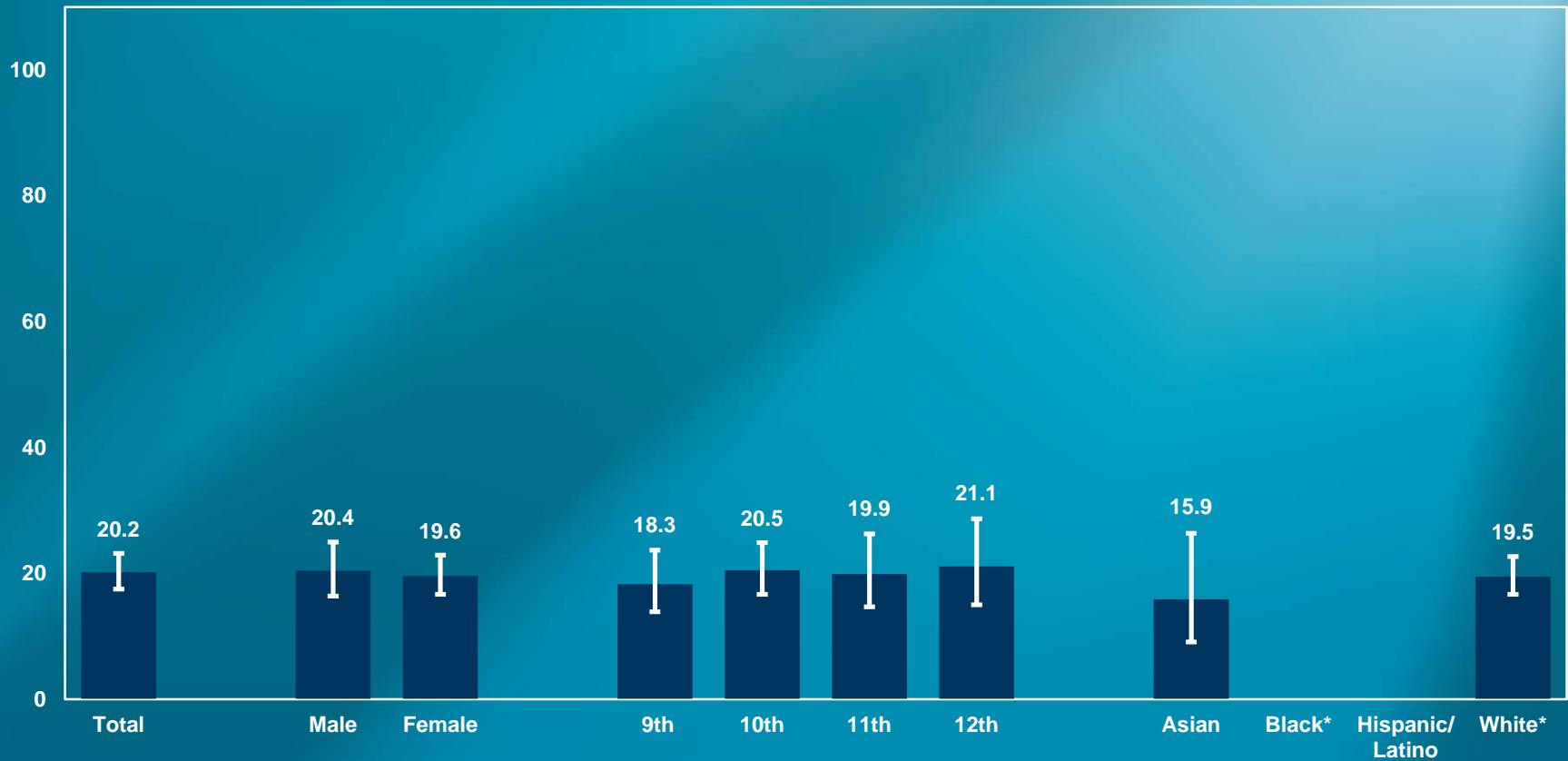

- 1,237 Students, 82% response rate

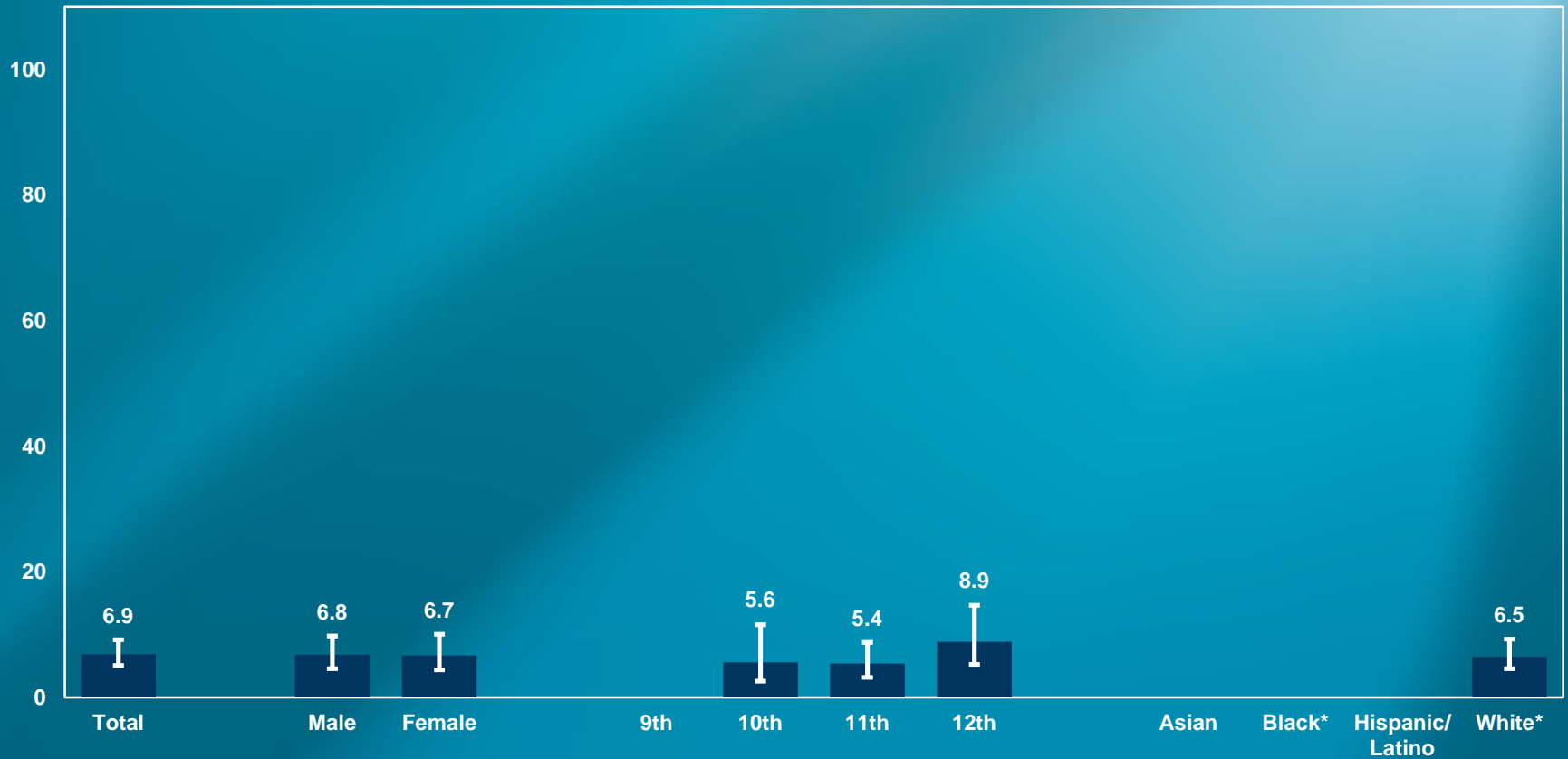

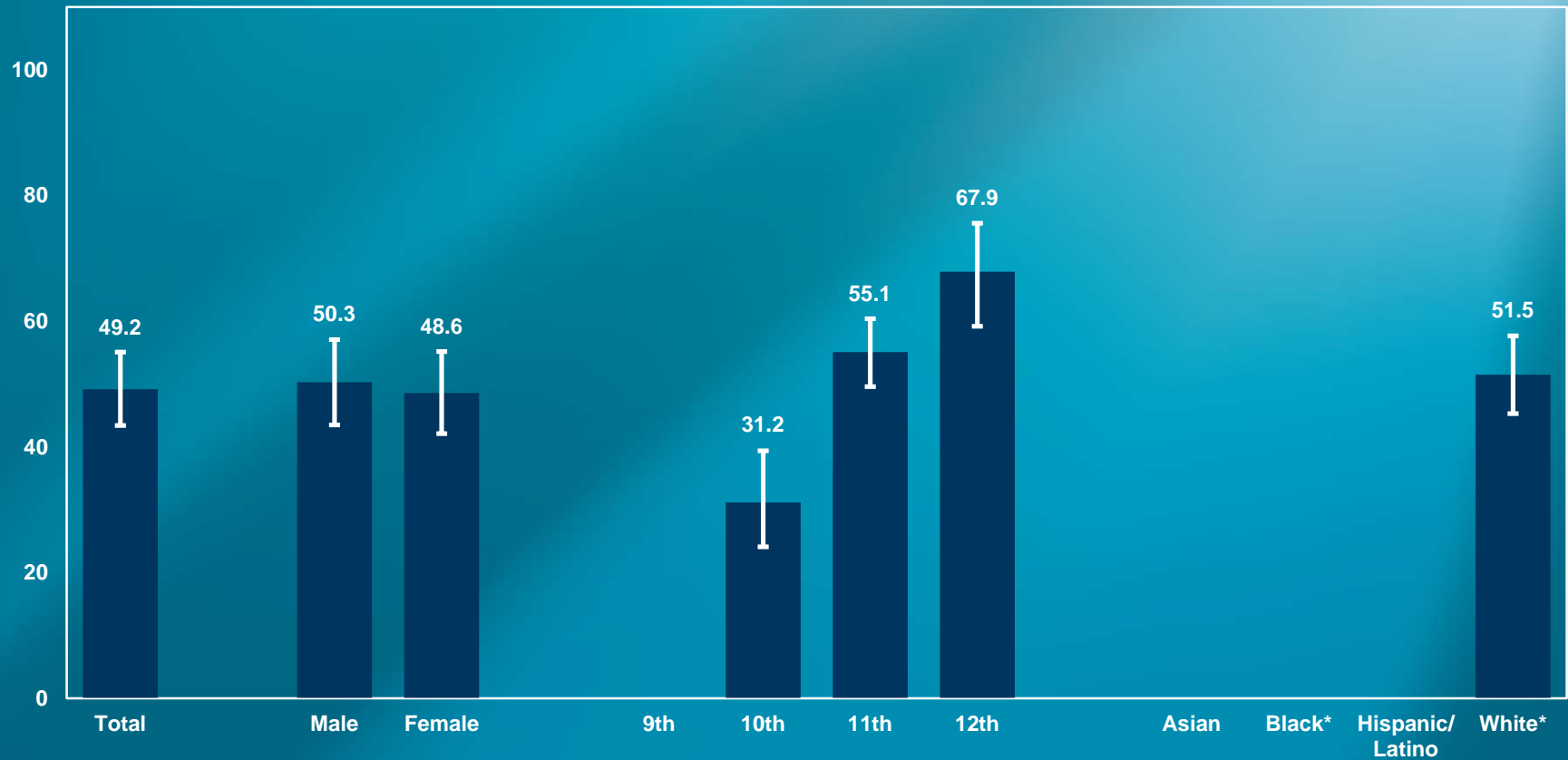

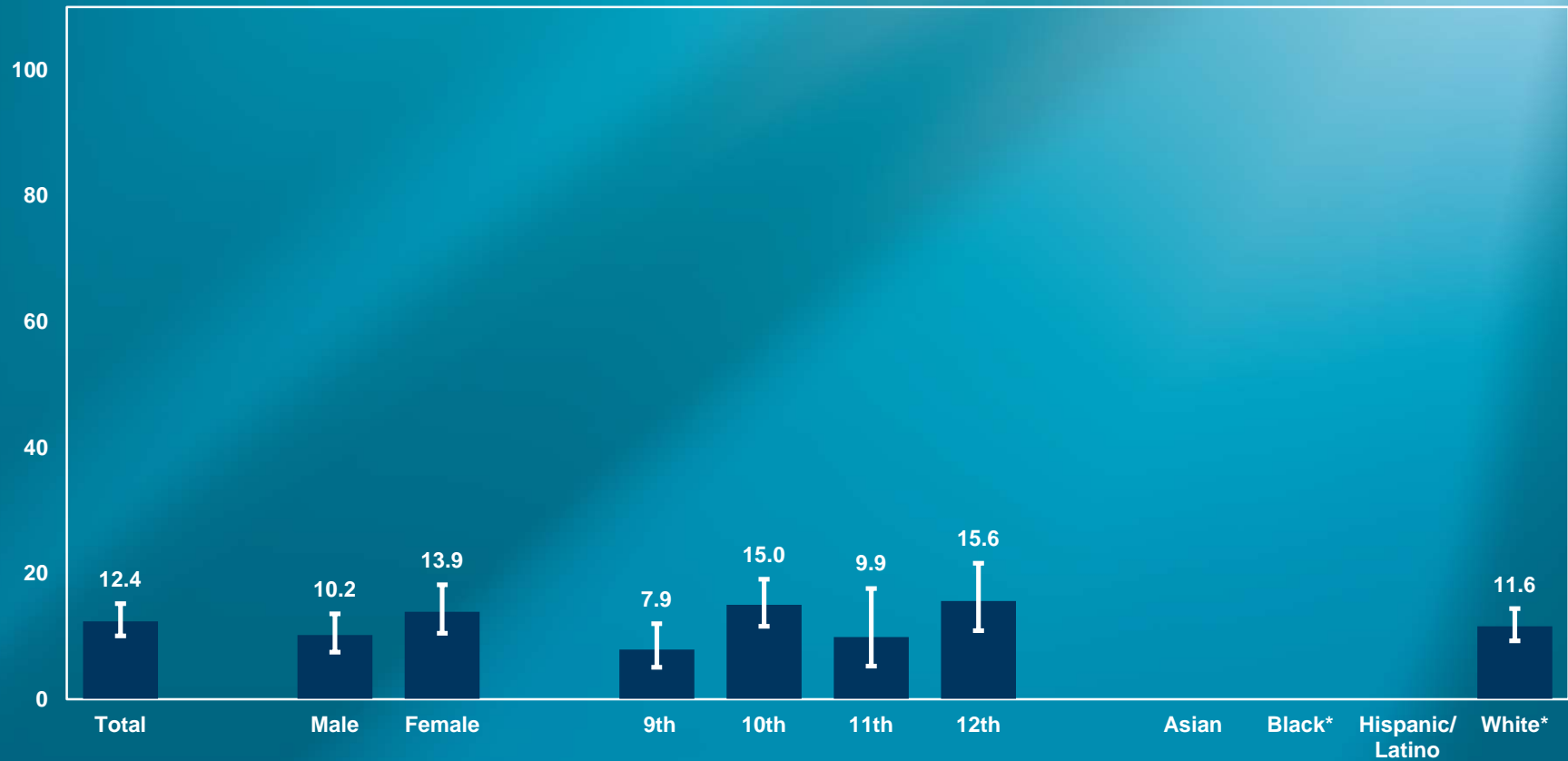

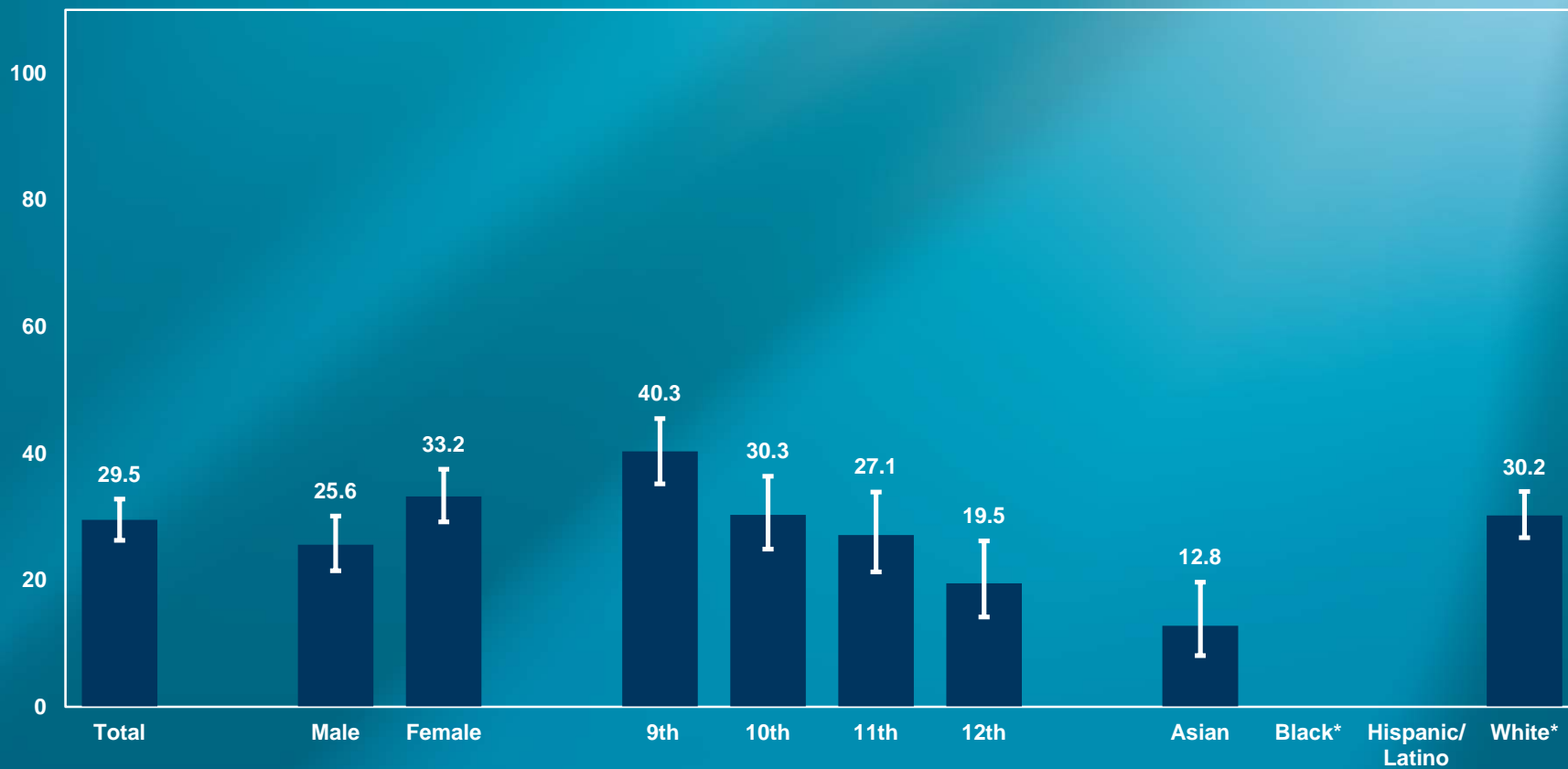

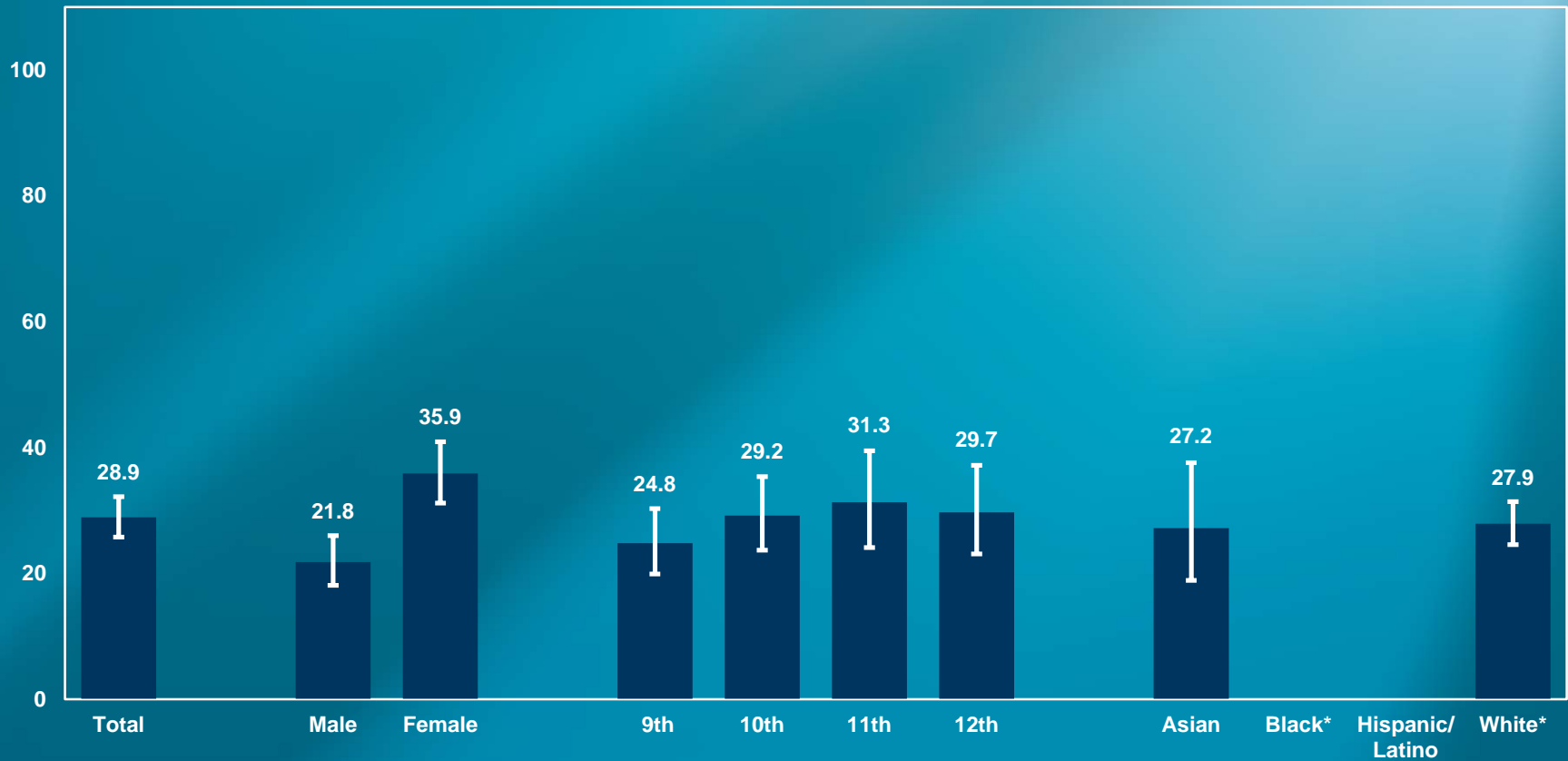

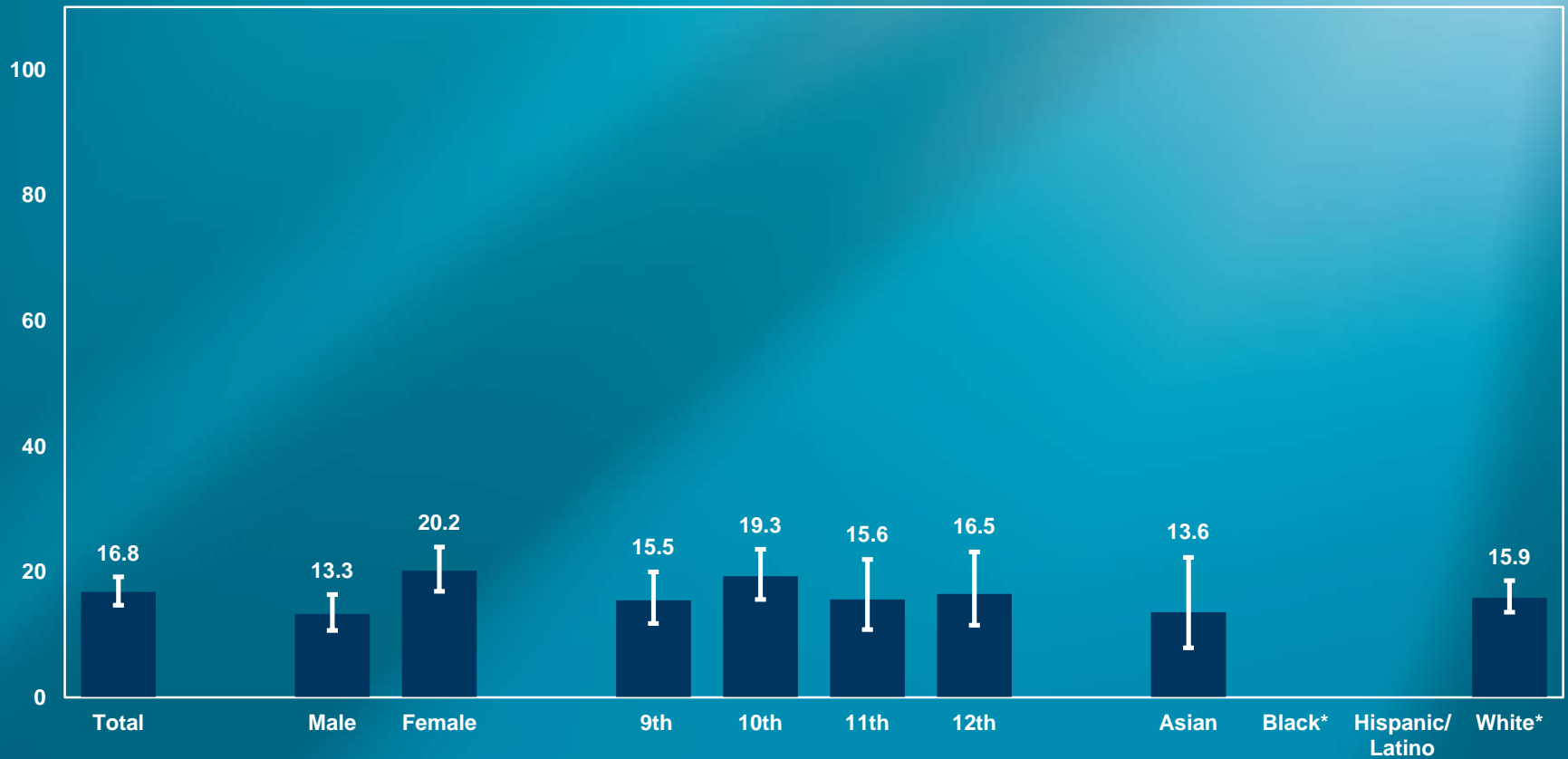

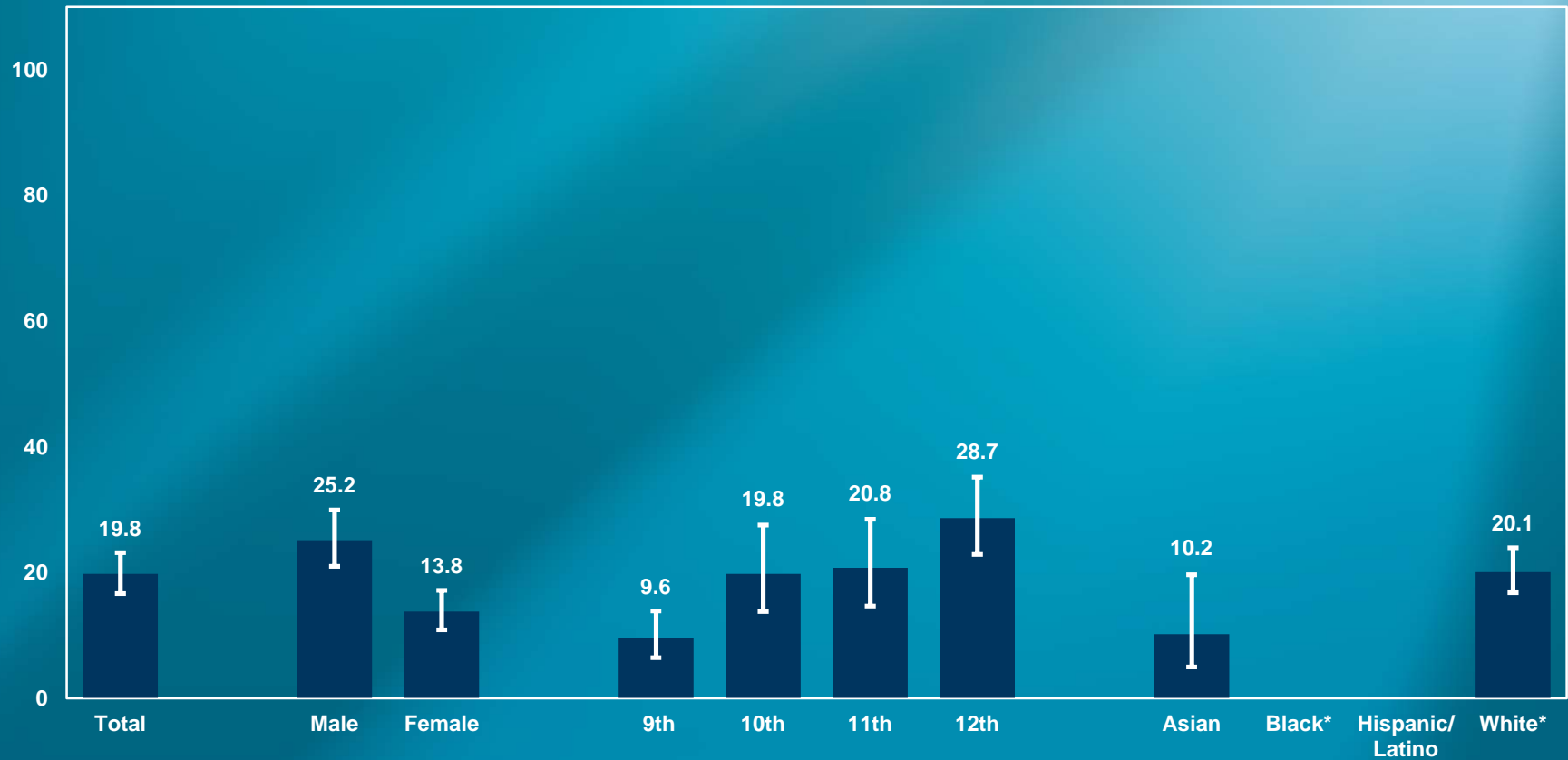

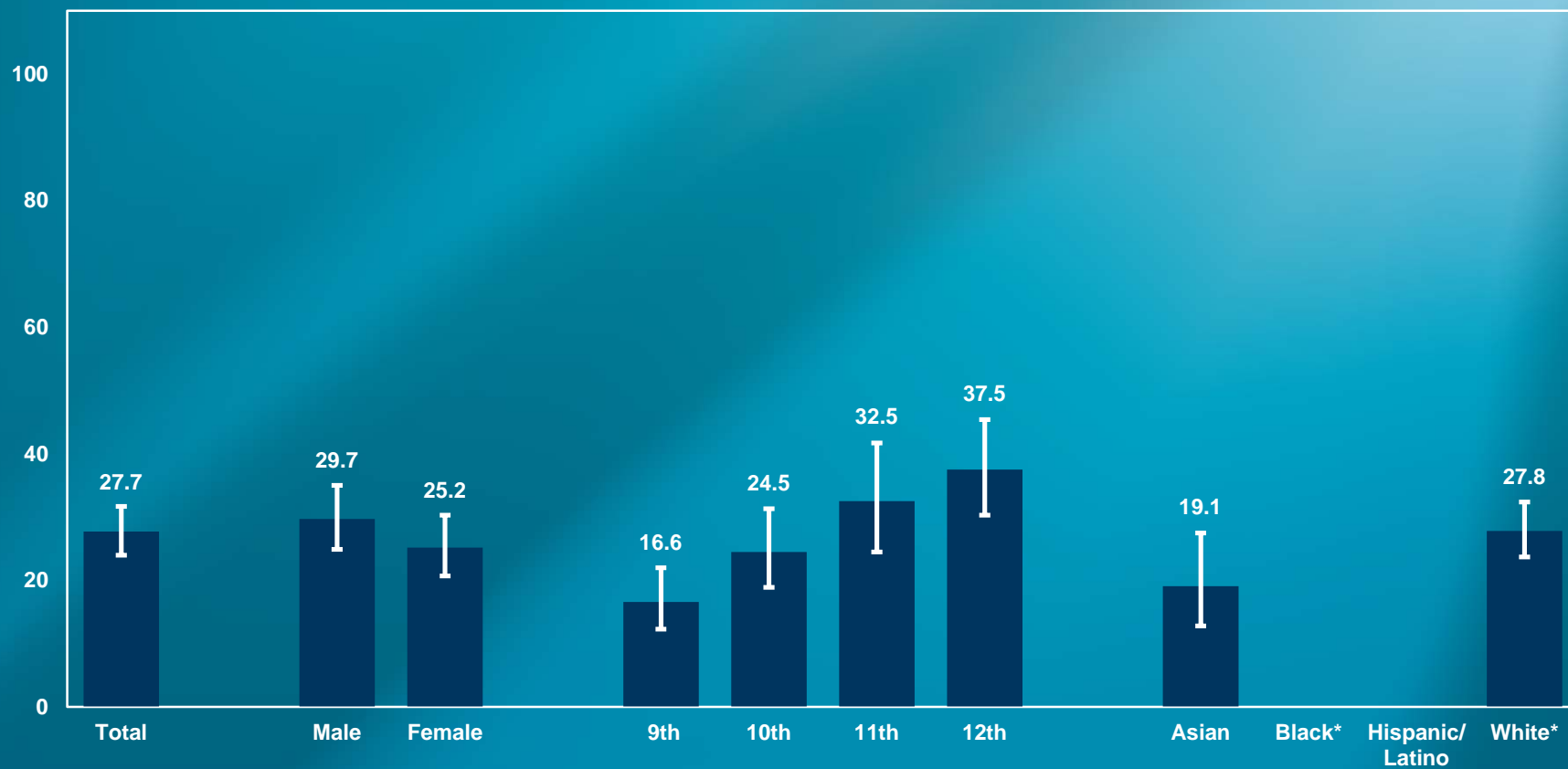

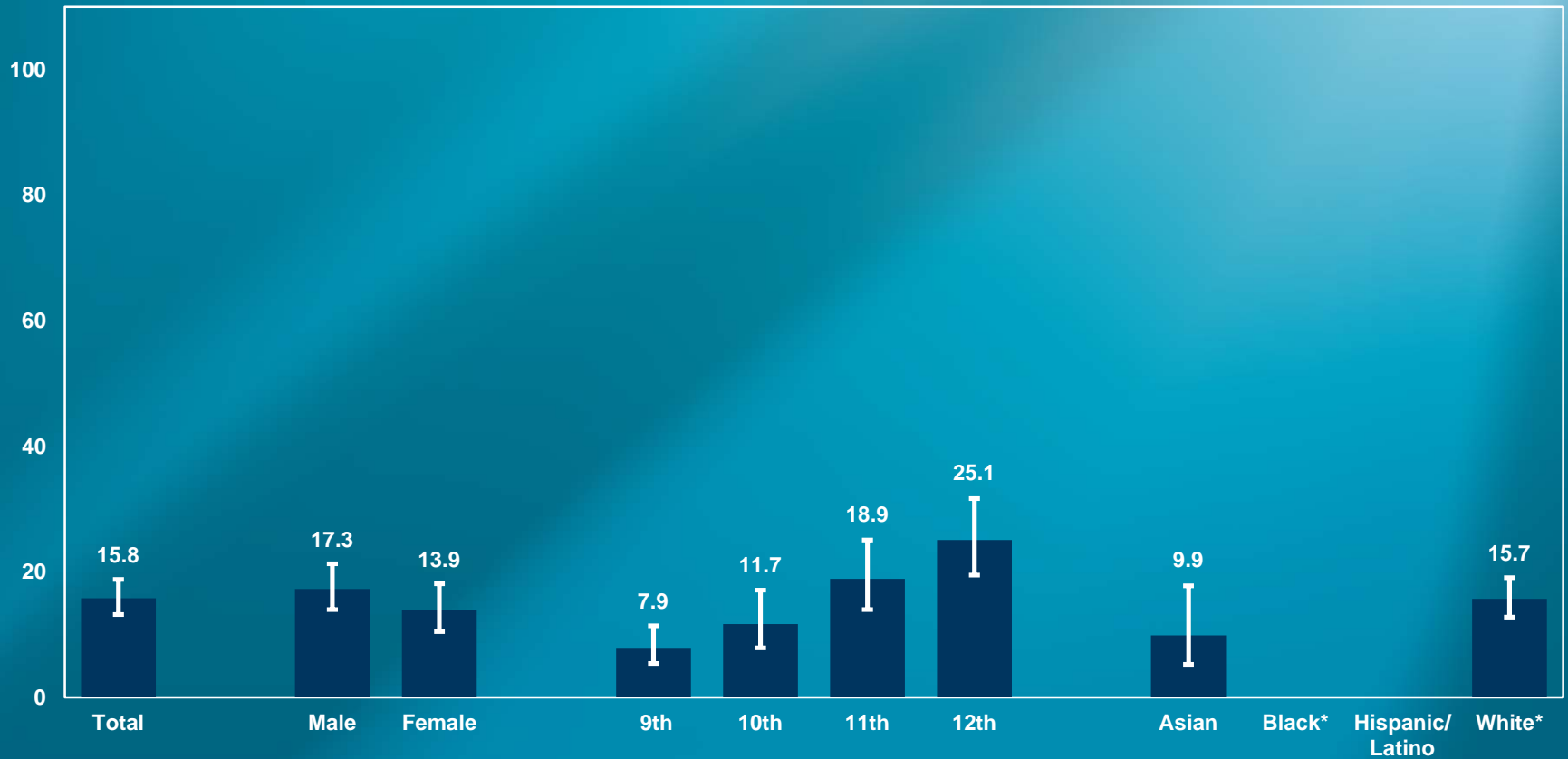

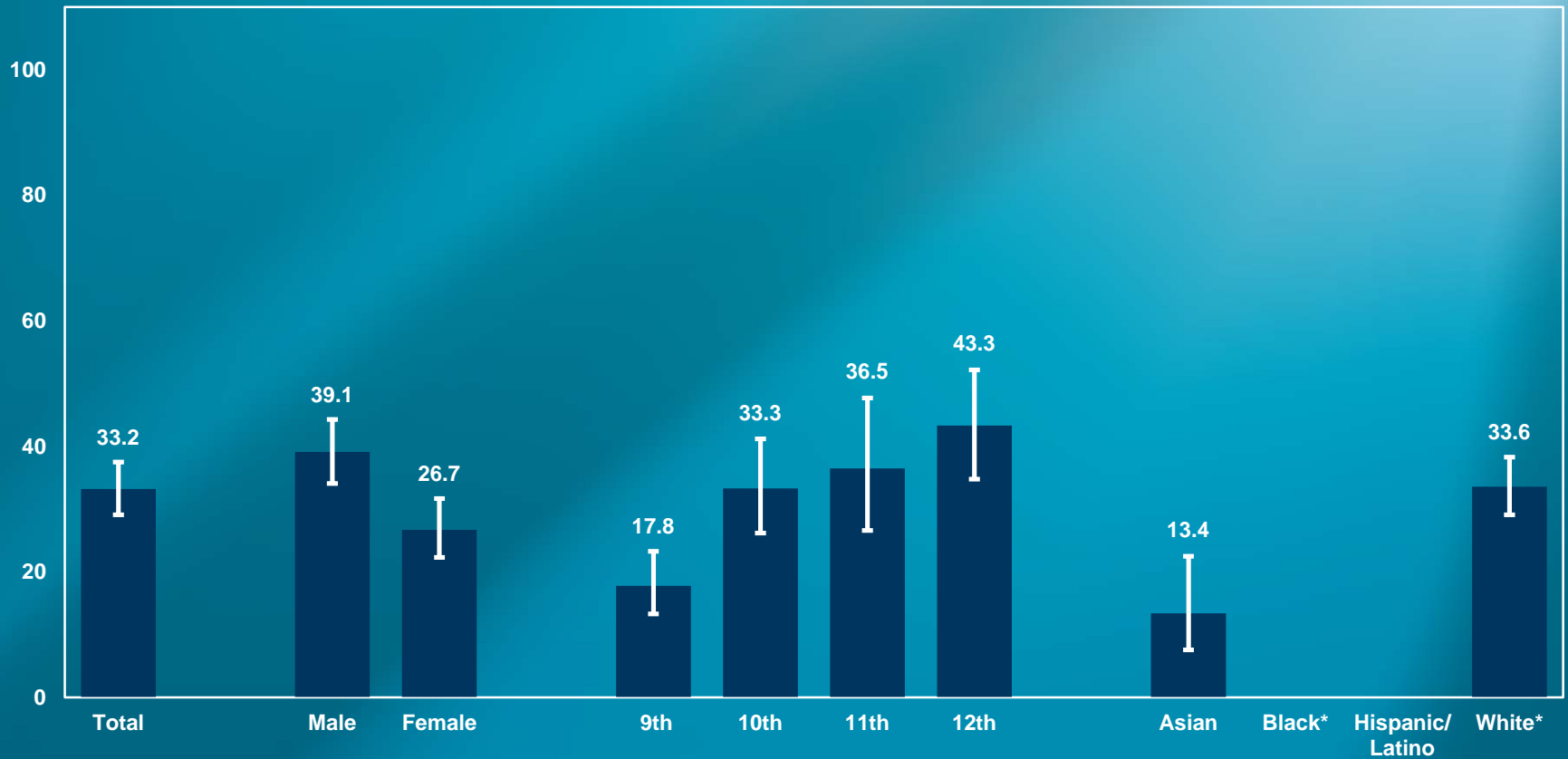

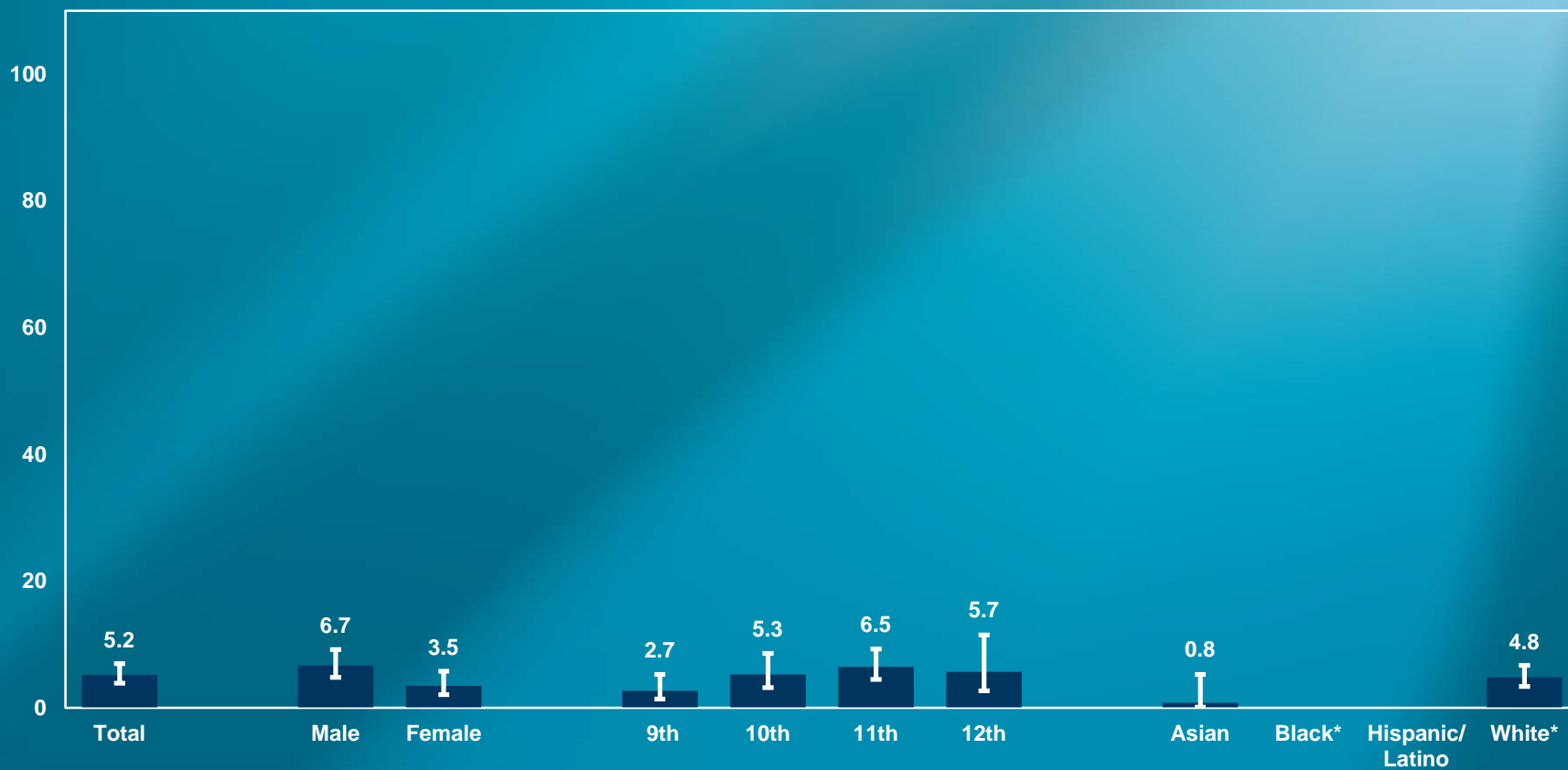

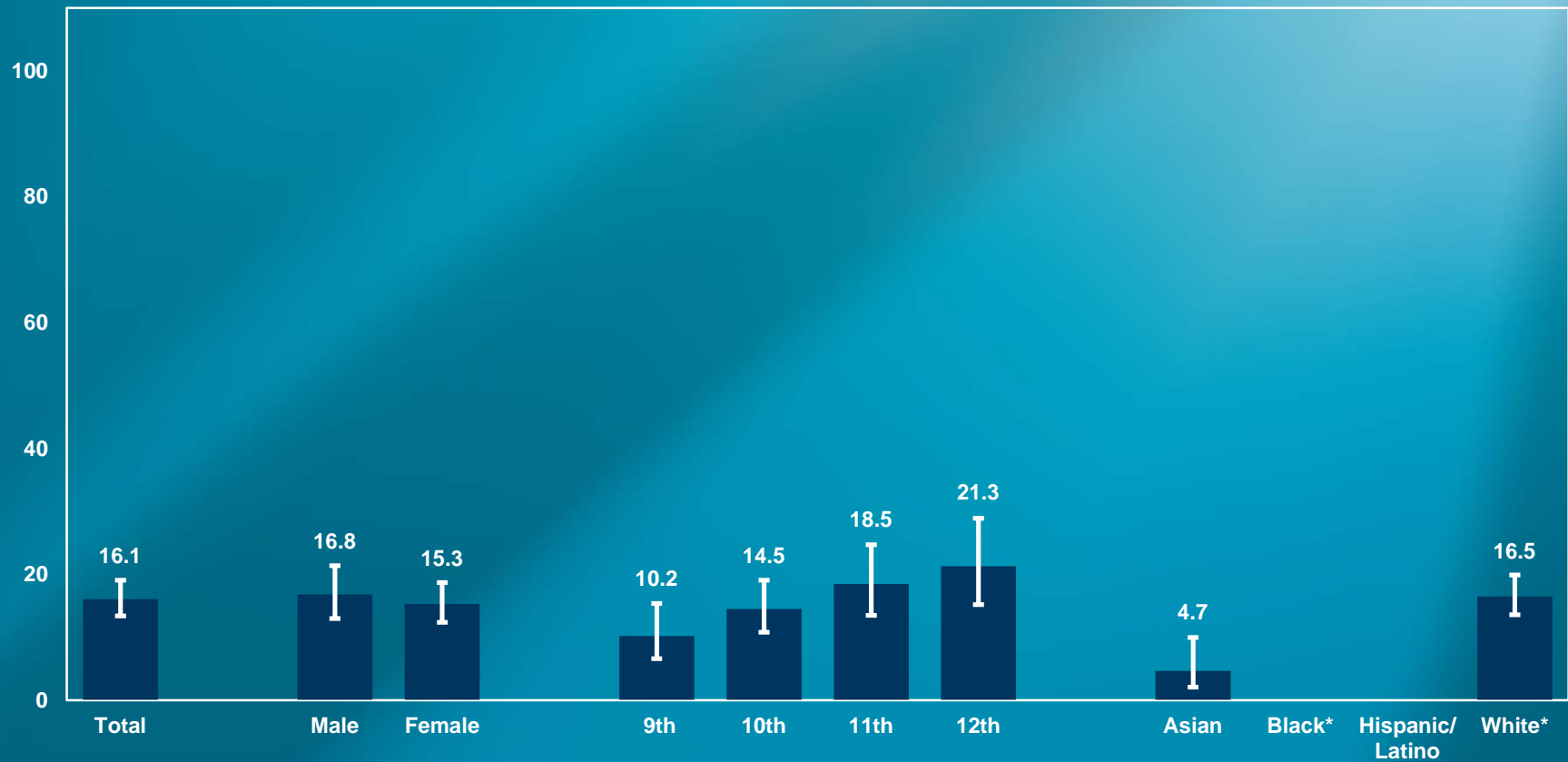

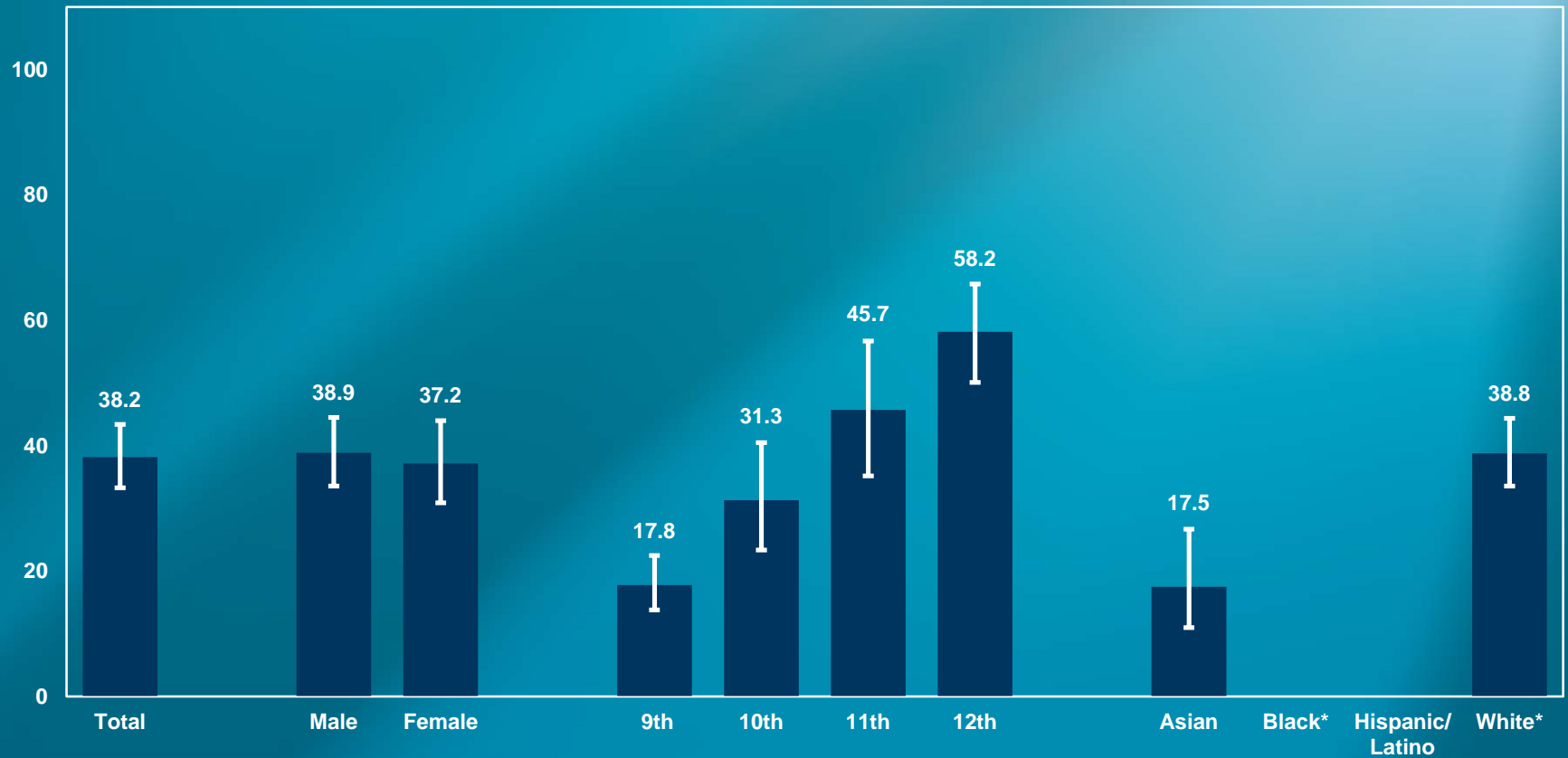

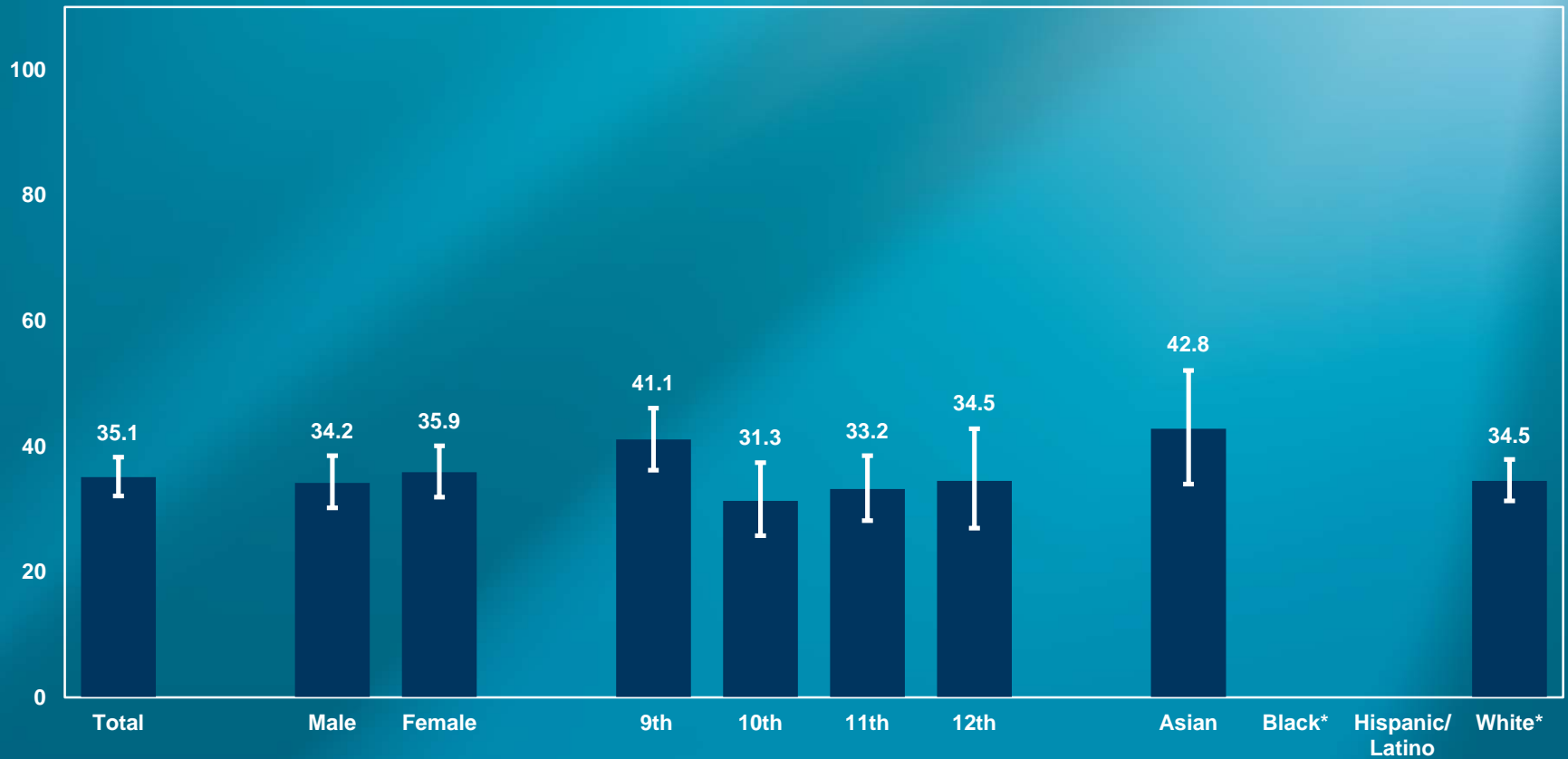

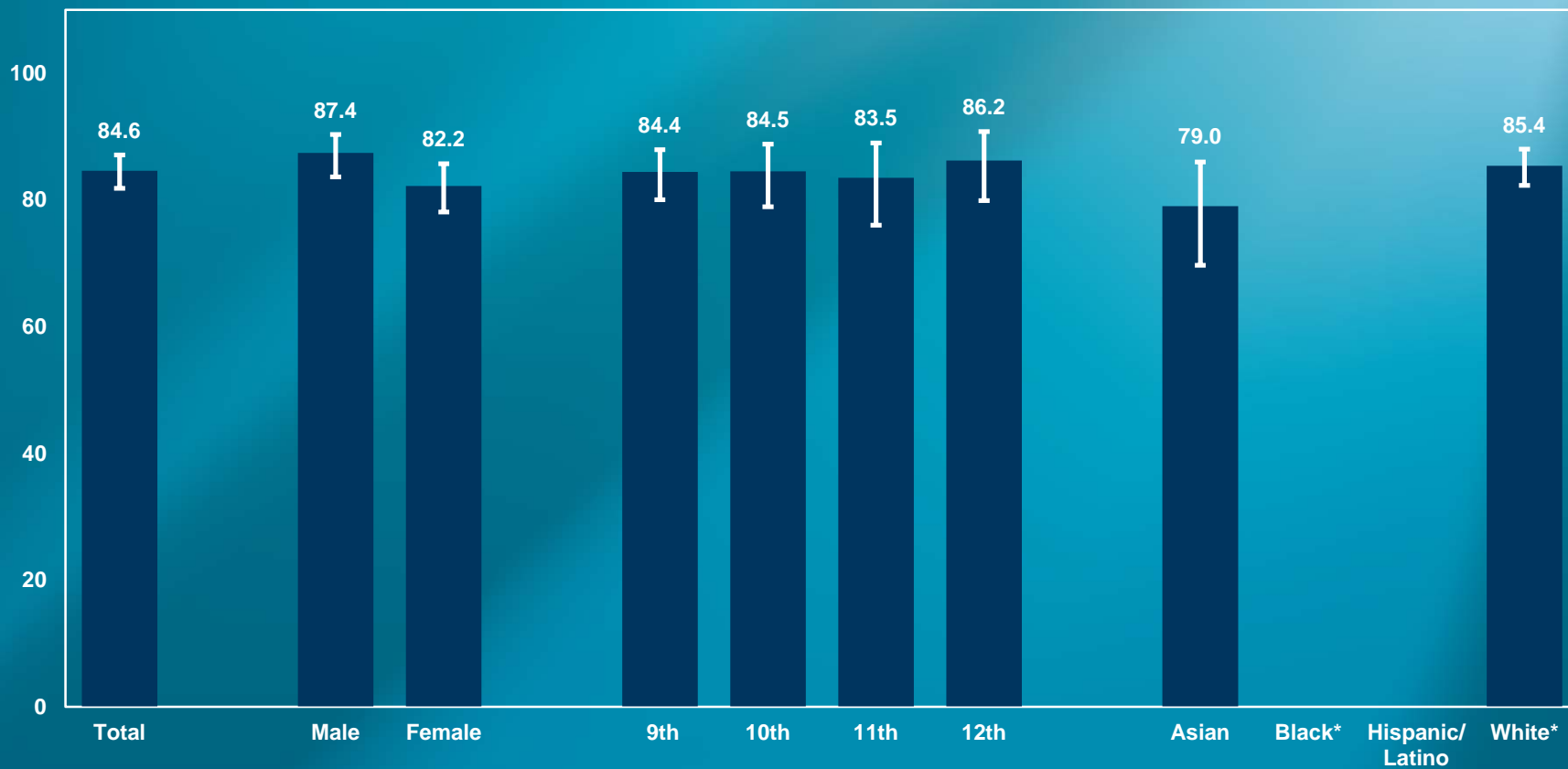

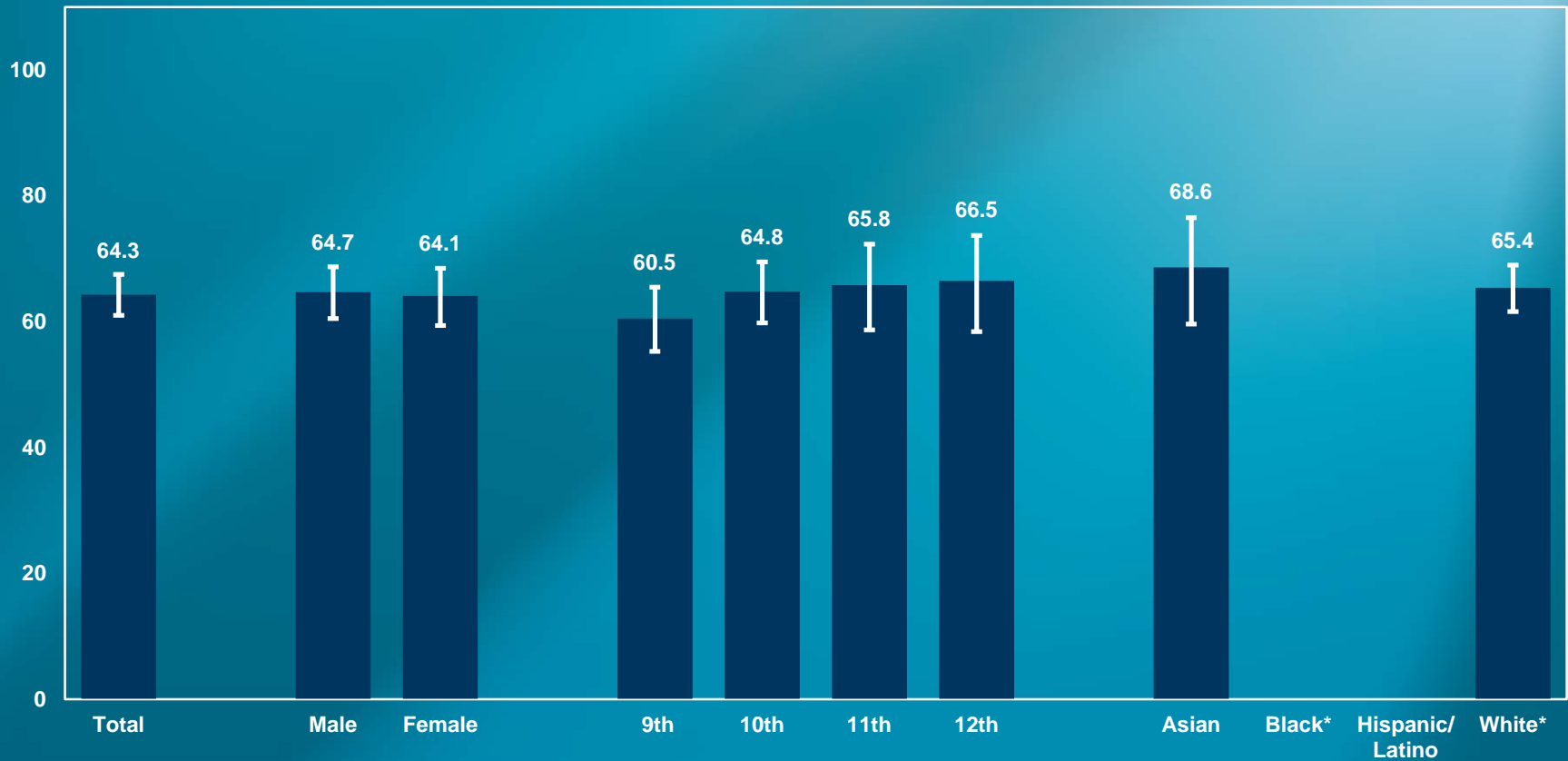

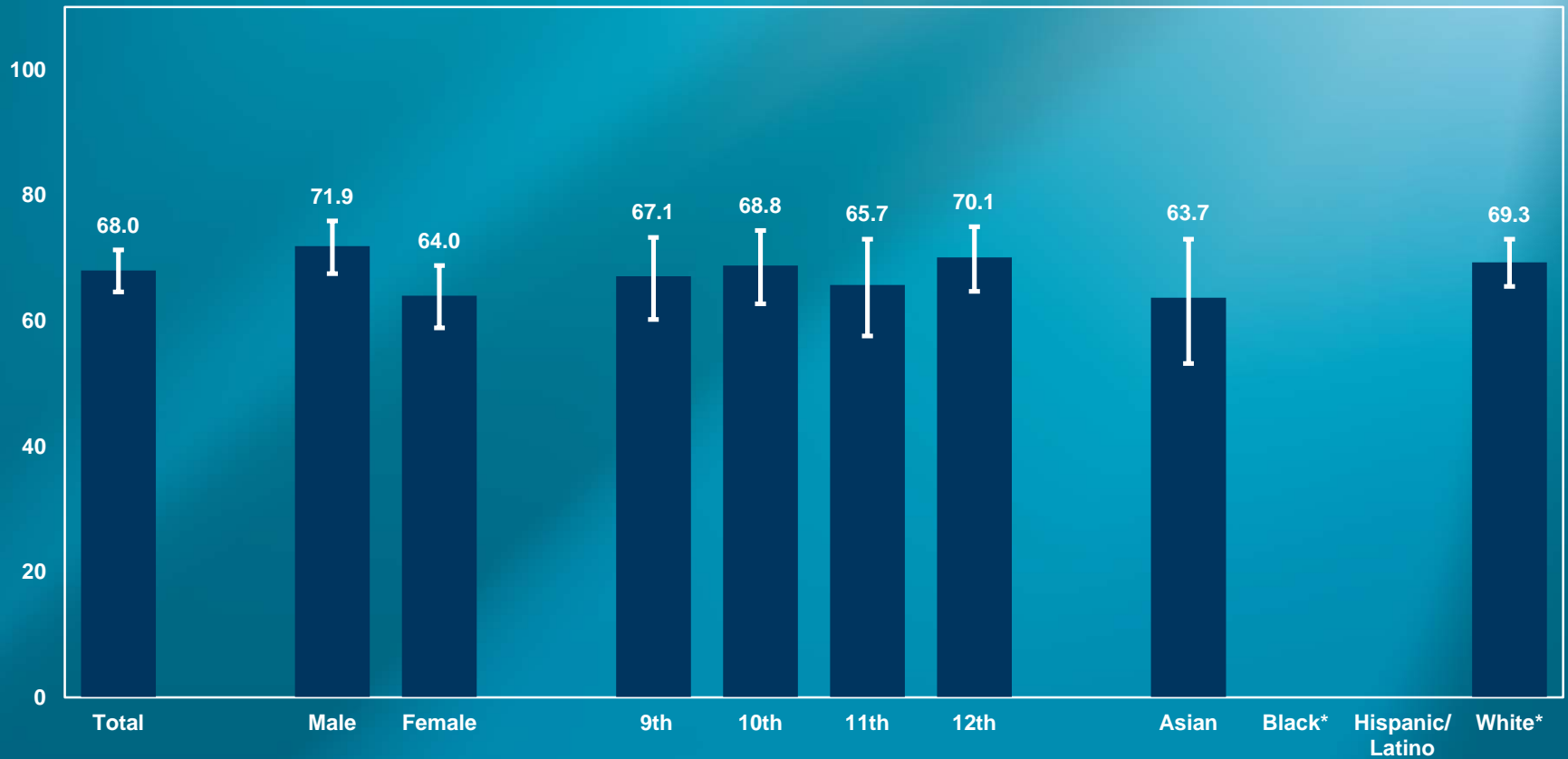

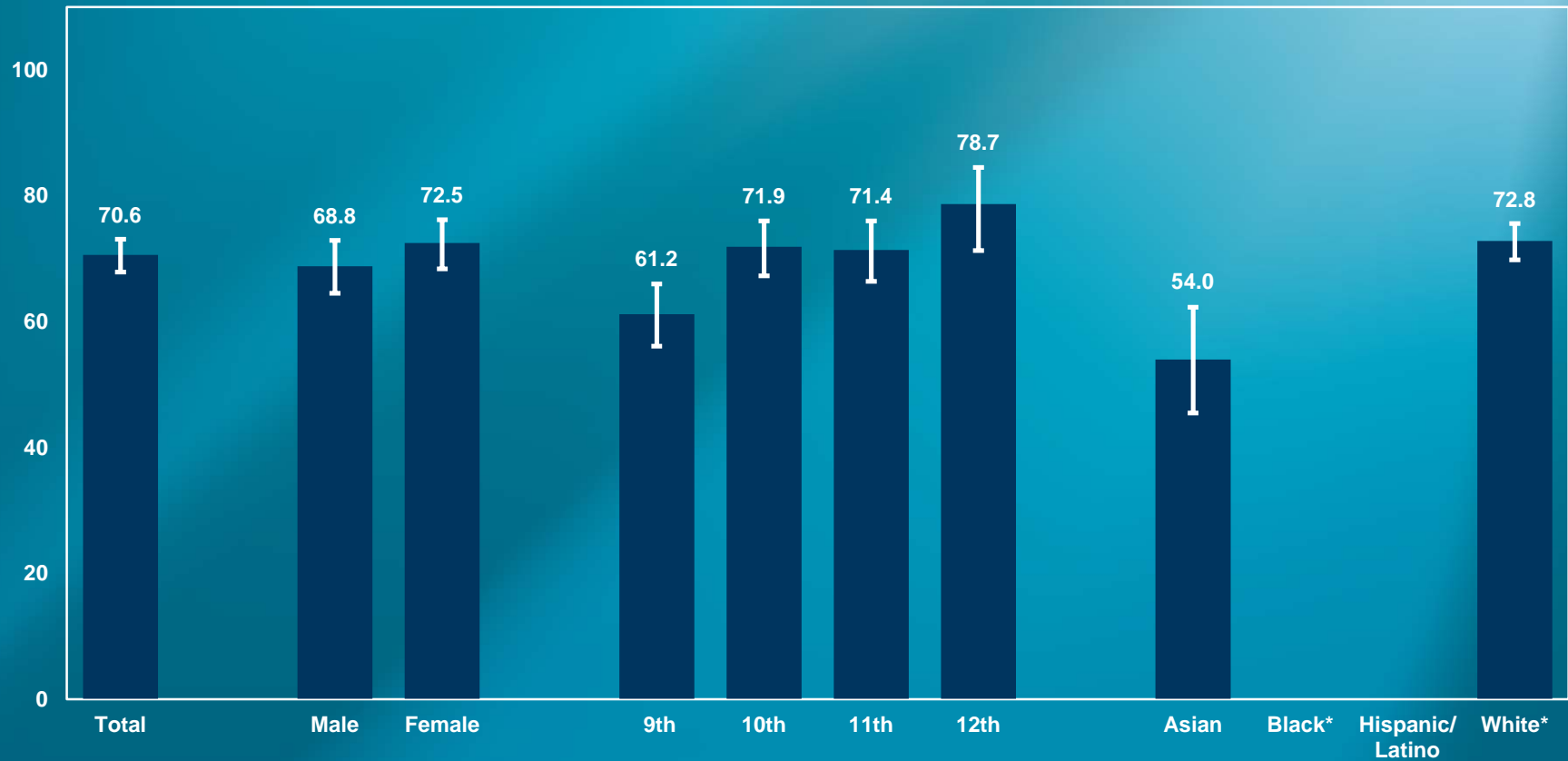

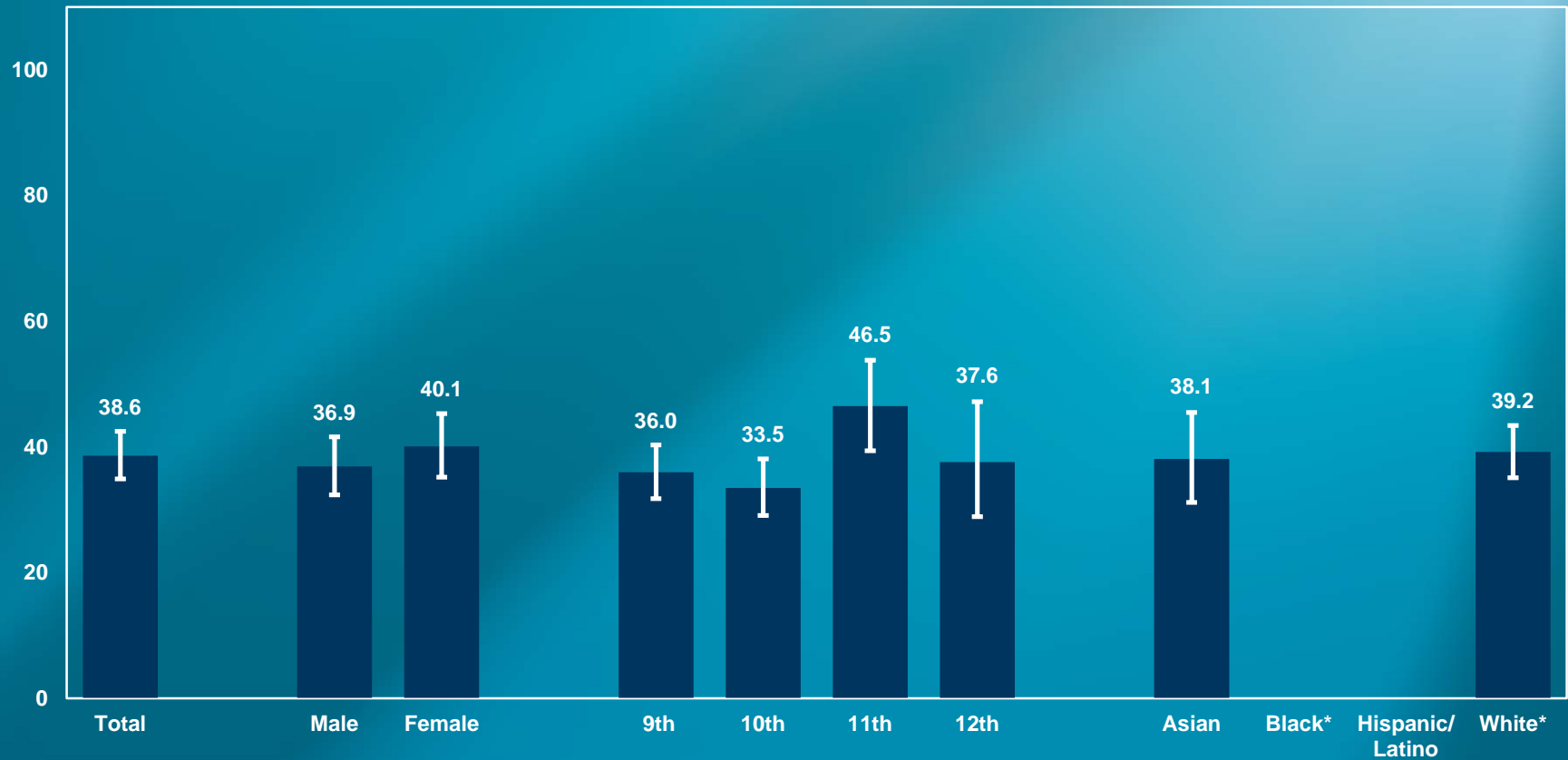

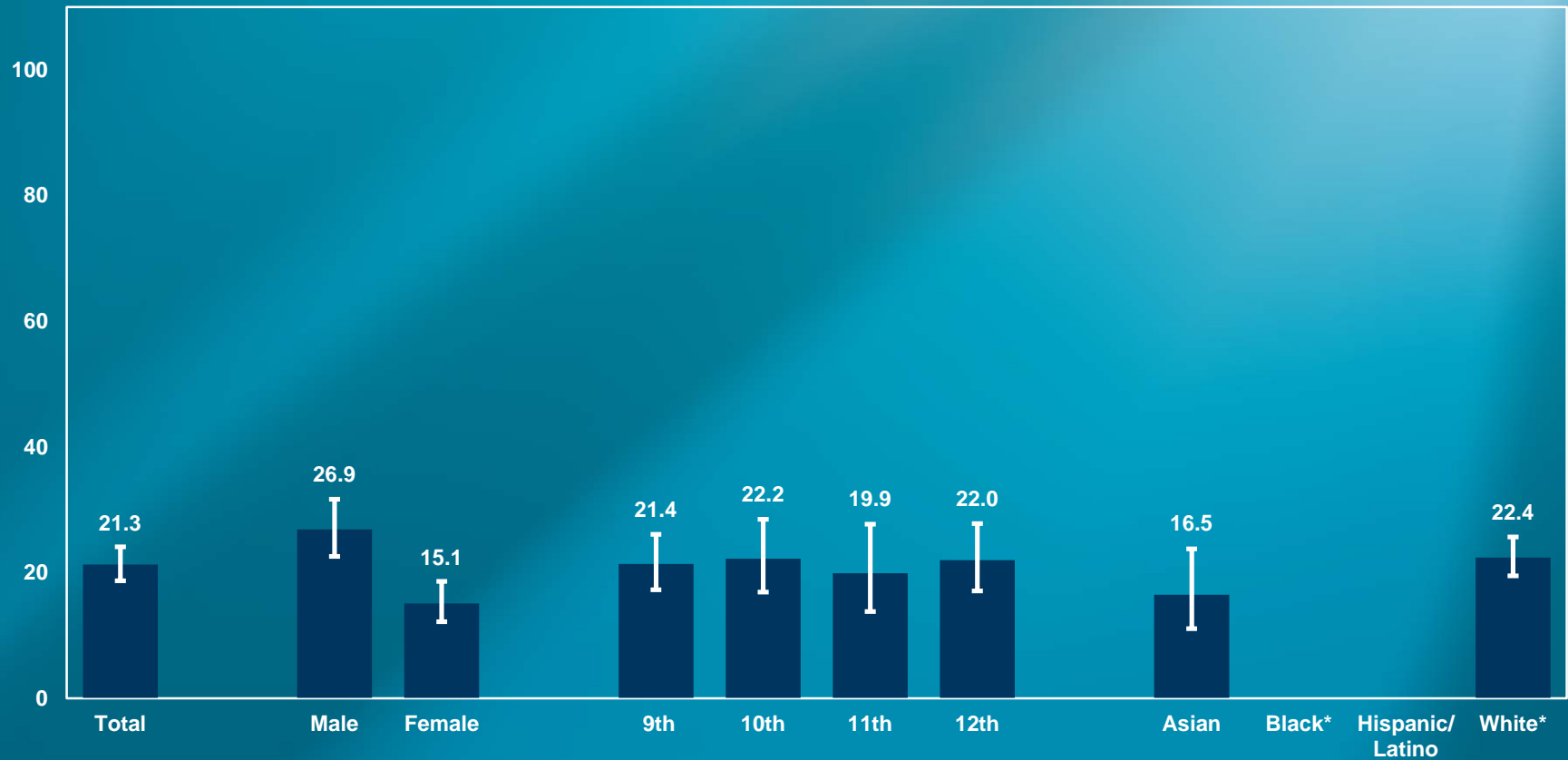

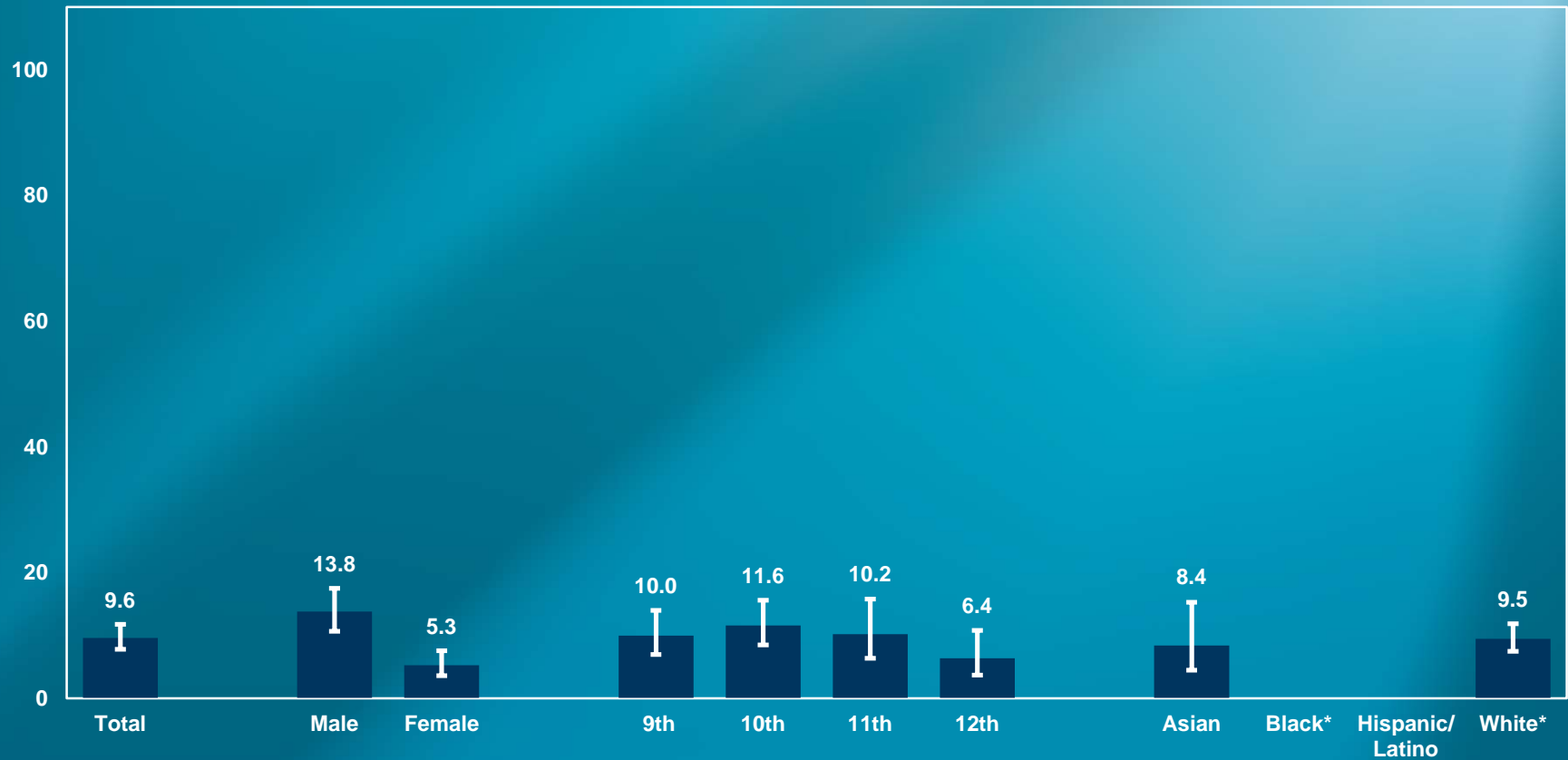

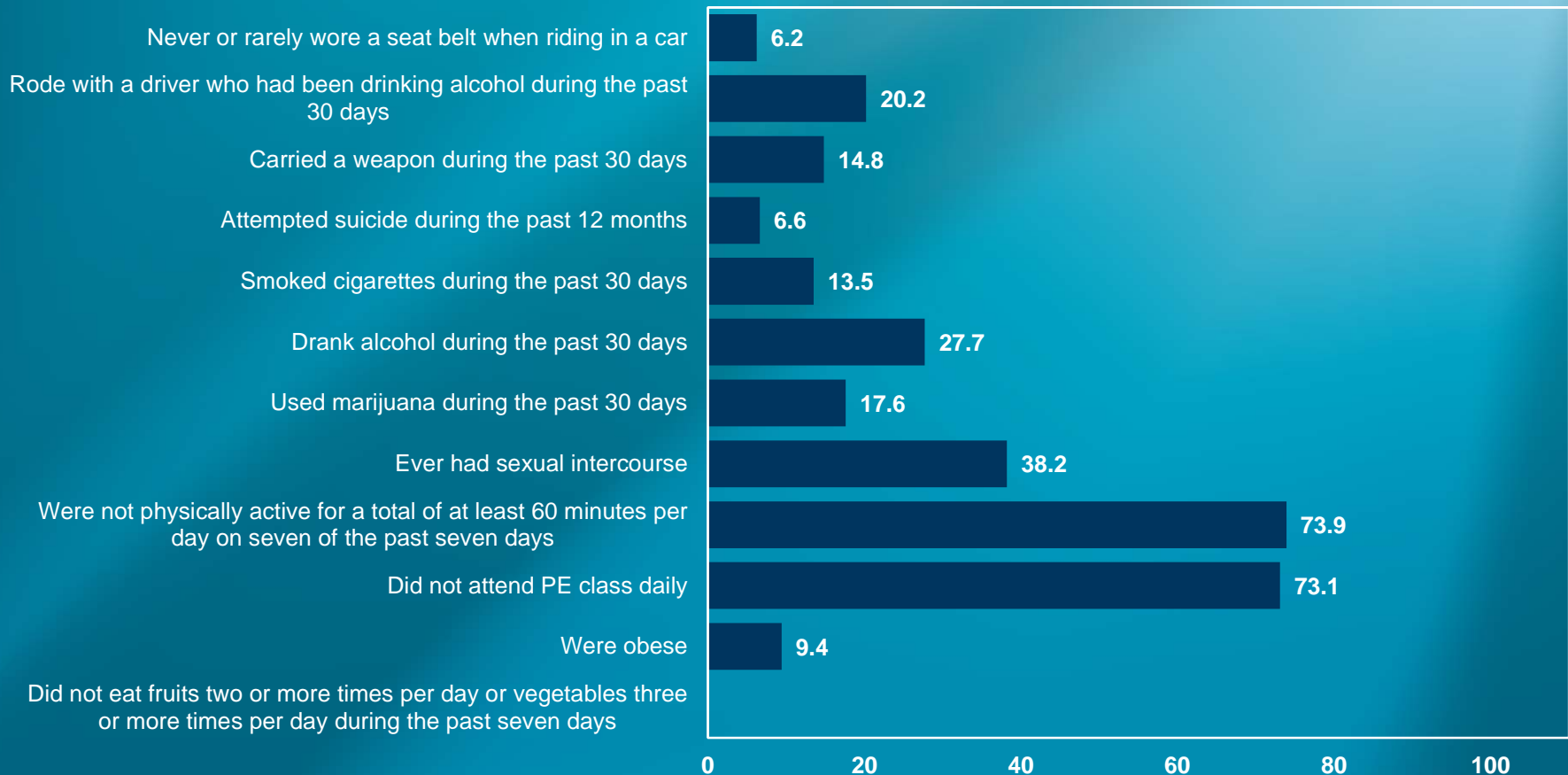

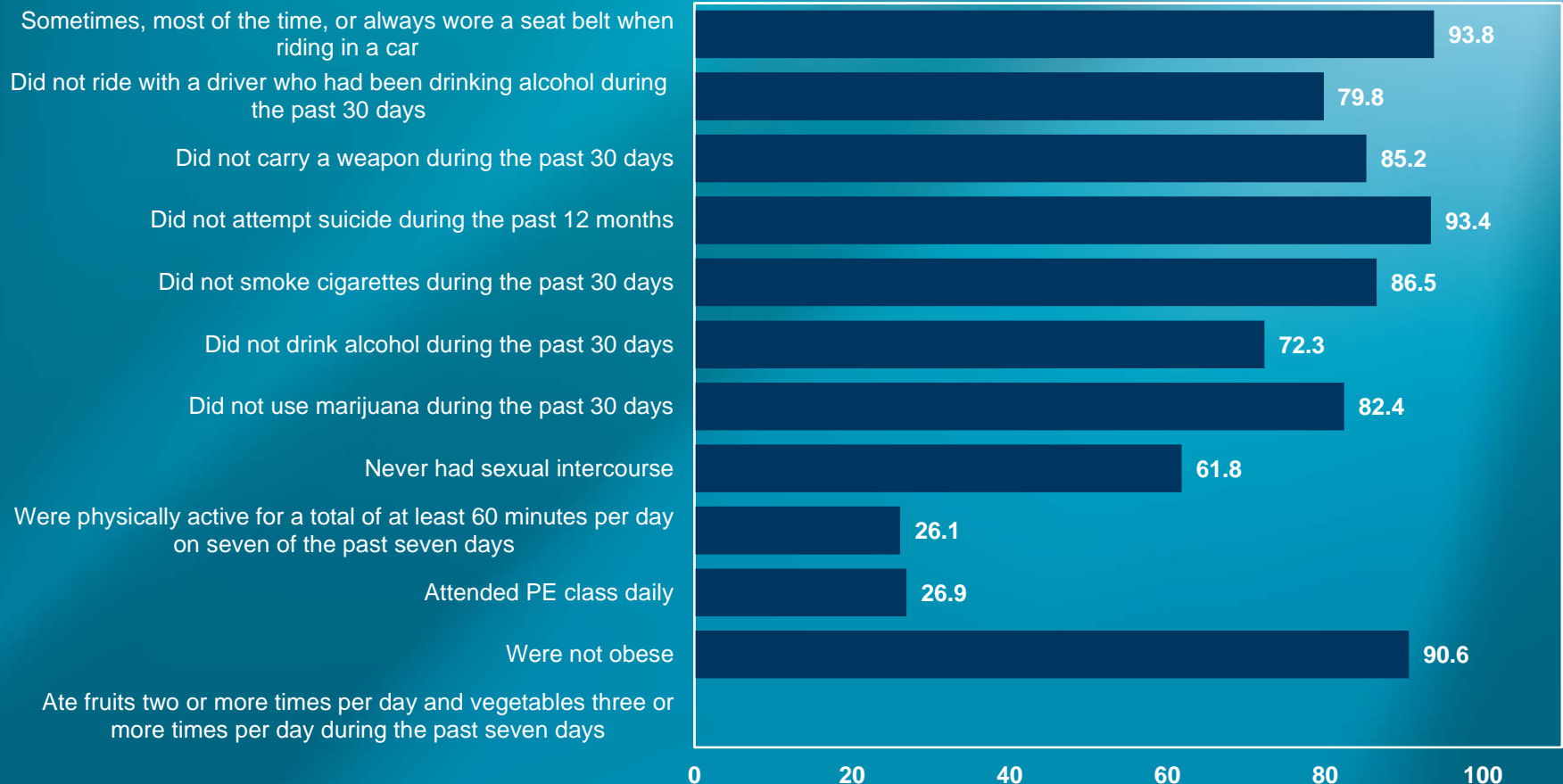

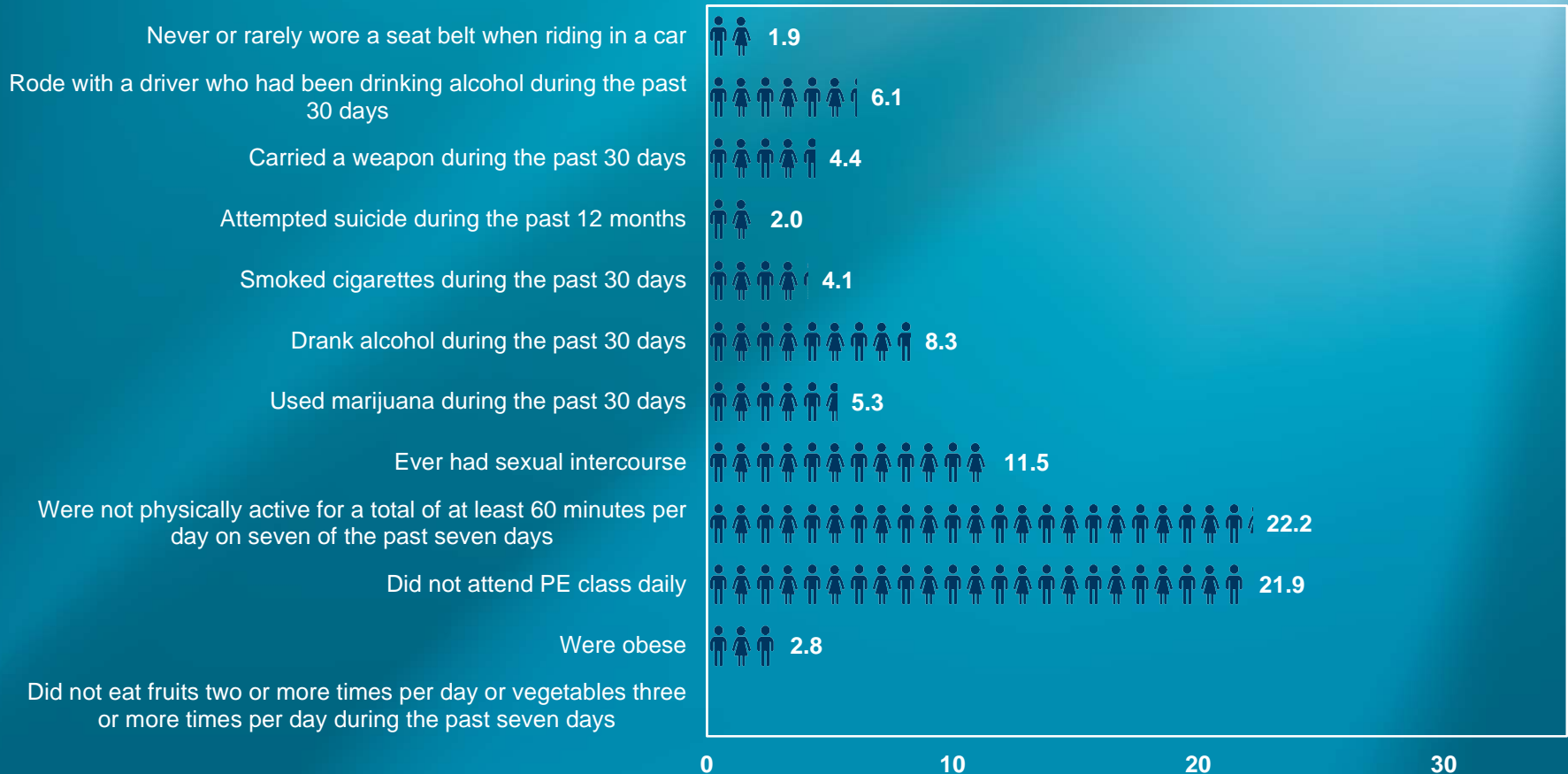

Number of students in a class of 30 who:

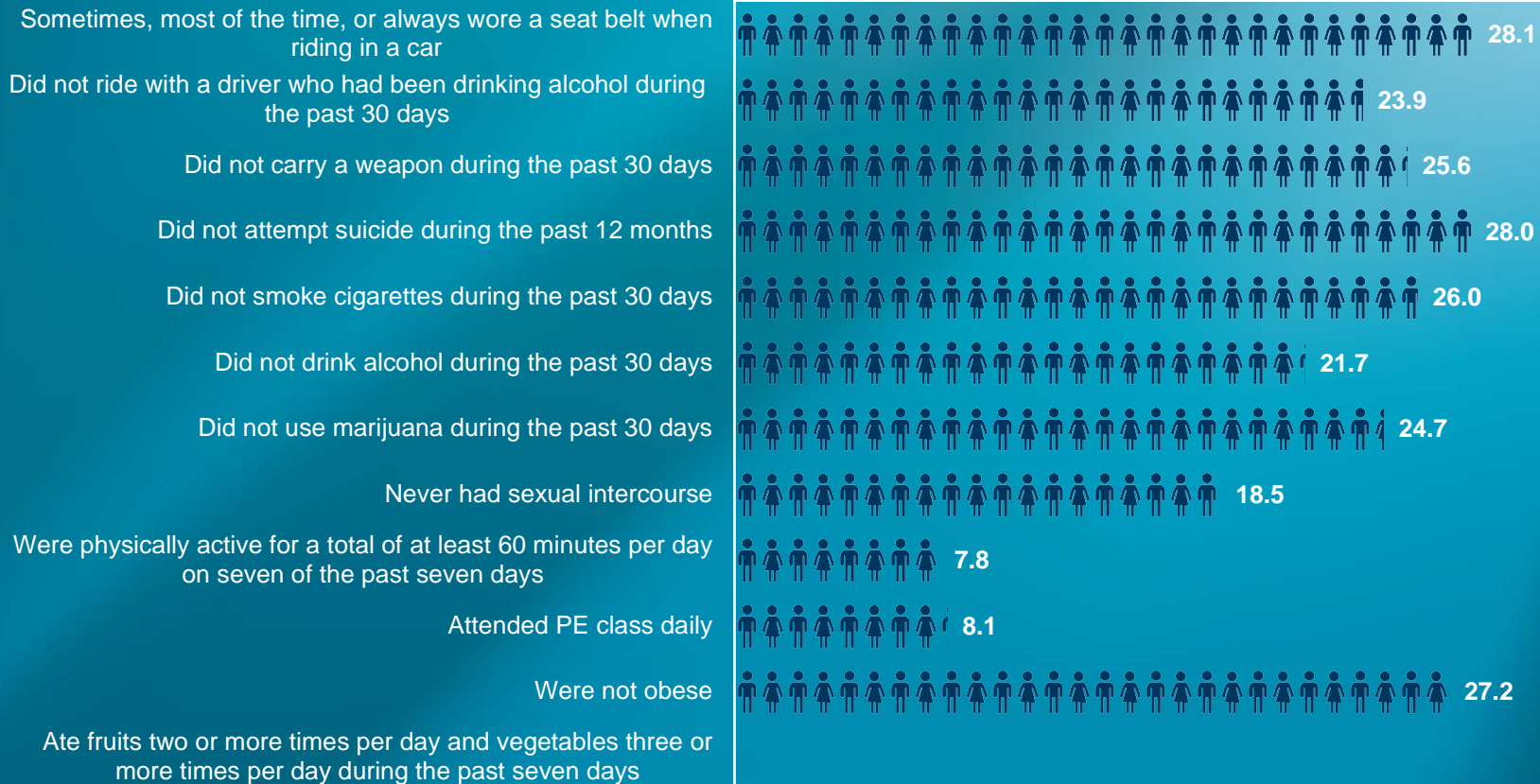

Trends from 2010-2013

Positive Trends

- Ever tried cigarettes Females (36% to 28%)
- Current alcohol use Females (34% to 25%)
- Current binge drinking Females (21% to 14%)
- Ecstasy use (8% to 5%)
- Offered, sold, or given illegal drug on schools property (20% to 16%)
- Daily soda consumption decreased from 28% to 21%

Challenges

- Did not go to school because felt unsafe (5% to 9%)
- Bullied past 12 months (24% to 30%)
- Depressed (23% to 29%, 36% Females)
- Suicide plan (10% to 16%, 20% Females)
- Marijuana-perception of risk (39% to 29%, 22% Males)
- Marijuana lifetime use by Males (30% to 39%)
- Feel they belong at school (73% to 68%)
- Daily “screen time” of more than 3 hours increased from 24% to 35%
- LGBTQ youth report increase risk of behaviors: unsafe at school, being bullied, dating violence, depression, suicide, tobacco use, other drug use
