La Crosse County Youth Risk Behavior Survey was completed by high school students in La Crosse County in January-March 2019 in the School Districts of: Bangor, Holmen, La Crosse, Onalaska, and West Salem. Arrows show increases ♠ or decreases ♦ in student behavior trends from the previous year greater than 2%. The Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction with the support of CESA has administered the YRBS in La Crosse every two years since 2010. The survey is self-administered online and anonymous. The 2019 results have been weighted and cleaned according to CDC methodology.
